RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE A.W. BROWN FELLOWSHIP LEADERSHIP ACADEMY AUTHORIZING CERTAIN WAIVERS AND CHARTER EXPANSION AMENDMENTS

WHEREAS A.W. Brown-Fellowship Leadership Academy (the "Corporation") is a Texas non-profit corporation and holds an open enrollment charter granted by the Texas Education Agency (the "TEA") to operate public charter schools in Texas.

WHEREAS, 19 TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE §100.1033 (the "Code") provides for the revision of the terms of an open-enrollment charter school through an expansion amendment approved by the commissioner of education; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Corporation seeks to expand its current operation, which will allow it to serve more students; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to alter the terms of its open-enrollment charter to increase maximum student enrollment from 2200 students to 5000 students; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to alter the terms of its open-enrollment charter to add additional campus(es); and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to alter the terms of its open-enrollment charter to expand the geographic boundaries of its service area by adding the school districts listed in <u>Exhibit A</u>; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the requested expansion amendments, the Corporation will apply for a waiver of rule 19 Tex. ADMIN. CODE (TAC) §100.1033(b)(9)(A)(iii) relating to academic accountability at 90% of campuses, 19 TAC §100.1033(b)(10)(D)(ii)(I) requiring at least 50% of students to be in STAAR tested grades, and any other waiver required to facilitate the expansion amendment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to TEX. EDUC. CODE § 7.056 a district may apply to the commissioner for a waiver of a requirement, restriction, or prohibition imposed by the Texas Education Code or commissioner rule; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to apply for such a waiver and authorizes the Superintendent or his designee to take such action necessary to execute the waiver; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes it is in the best interest of students to seek the aforementioned waiver and expansion amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed and considered a comprehensive business plan comprised of the following components: a statement discussing the need for the requested expansion; a statement discussing the current and projected financial condition of the charter holder and charter school; an unaudited statement of financial position for the current fiscal year; an unaudited statement of cash flows for the current fiscal year; a pro forma budget that includes the costs

of operating the charter school, including the implementation of the expansion amendment; a statement or schedule that identifies the assumptions used to calculate the charter school's estimated Foundation School Program revenues; a statement discussing the use of debt instruments to finance part or all of the charter school's incremental costs; a statement discussing the incremental cost of acquiring additional facilities, furniture, and equipment to accommodate the anticipated increase in student enrollment; and a statement discussing the incremental cost of additional on-site personnel and identifying the additional number of full-time equivalents that will be employed; and

WHEREAS, the Board, in compliance with the Code, proposes to send letters of notification to surrounding school districts evidencing any impact on those districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

- 1. The Board APPROVES and ADOPTS the charter amendment request form attached hereto and made a part hereof as <u>Exhibit B</u>.
- 2. The Superintendent or a designee is hereby AUTHORIZED and DIRECTED to execute a waiver of 19 TAC §100.1033(b)(9)(A)(iii) and §100.1033(b)(10)(D)(ii)(I) as the act and deed of the Corporation, and submit the same to the Texas Commissioner of Education with the request that it be approved
- 3. The Superintendent is hereby AUTHORIZED and DIRECTED to sign the charter amendment request form attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A as the act and deed of the Corporation and submit the same to the Texas Commissioner of Education with the request that it be approved and ordered pursuant to the Commissioner's decision.
- 4. The Board has considered a business plan and has determined that the proposed growth is prudent.
- 5. This Resolution and the Exhibit it adopts shall be made a part of the official minutes of the Board meeting at which it is adopted.
- 6. That the Board does hereby authorize the Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's duly authorized agent to send required notices and execute the instruments necessary to procure an amendment to the open-enrollment charter for the A.W. Brown Fellowship Leadership Academy.
